Top to Bottom Placement Now Acceptable on the Stars Sash

As you are no doubt aware, the Missionettes program was developed by the Assemblies of God. The IPHC has an agreement with the AG for using and customizing the curriculum for our own use. We change only those things that need to be changed to accurately reflect the IPHC doctrines, department names, policies, etc.

We also attempt to pass along changes made along the way by the Missionettes Ministries of the Assemblies of God. The following statement about an important change was issued by them in one of their quarterly communications:



“Since the release of the new curriculum, we've had the opportunity to evaluate some aspects of the Missionettes Clubs. The Stars Club badge placement is one of those aspects. Our office has received numerous requests to change the placement allowing badges to be placed from top to bottom rather than bottom to top. The original bottom to top placement was in keeping with the concept of girls going up the Stairway of the Stars. However, the new curriculum makes little or no reference to the stairway. Therefore, churches may now begin placing the badges top to bottom.”

The graphic to the right shows the new placement of step badges. Unit badges, however, can be earned in any order. This placement is for guidance only.

Note: This new placement was announced in September 2004. As new sashes are begun, we suggest you use this new placement since it is easier. However, there is no need to change those sashes already begun from bottom to top.
